1. Summary of Scholarship system



- ◆ The main purpose of all scholarships is to assist highly talented students who excel academically and who are of excellent character but have difficulties in continuing their studies due to financial reasons.
- ◆ This slide outlines scholarships for privately-financed international students whose status of residence in Japan is “Student”. If your status of residence is either “Permanent resident”, “Special Permanent resident”, “Long-term resident”, “Dependent” or “Child or spouse of Japanese national (permanent resident)”, please refer to scholarship information for Japanese national as below.

- ◆ If you wish to apply for a scholarship offered by the Keio International Center, your status of residence must be “Student”. Those whose visa status is other than “Student” will be able to apply if they change their status to “Student”. Please consider and decide whether you change your visa status or not because there are advantages or disadvantages as well as things you are allowed or not allowed to do depending on your visa status.

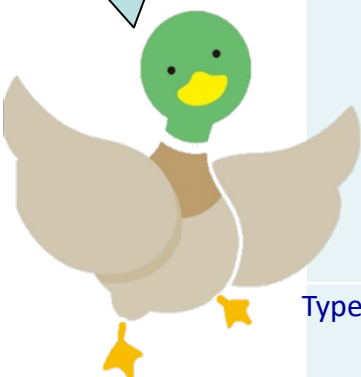
Scholarship Category



◆ There are 3 main types of scholarship; ① Internal Scholarship (awarded by Keio), ② Offered by the Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho) and other public entities such as Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO), ③ Offered by the scholarship organizations, including private companies and scholarship foundations.

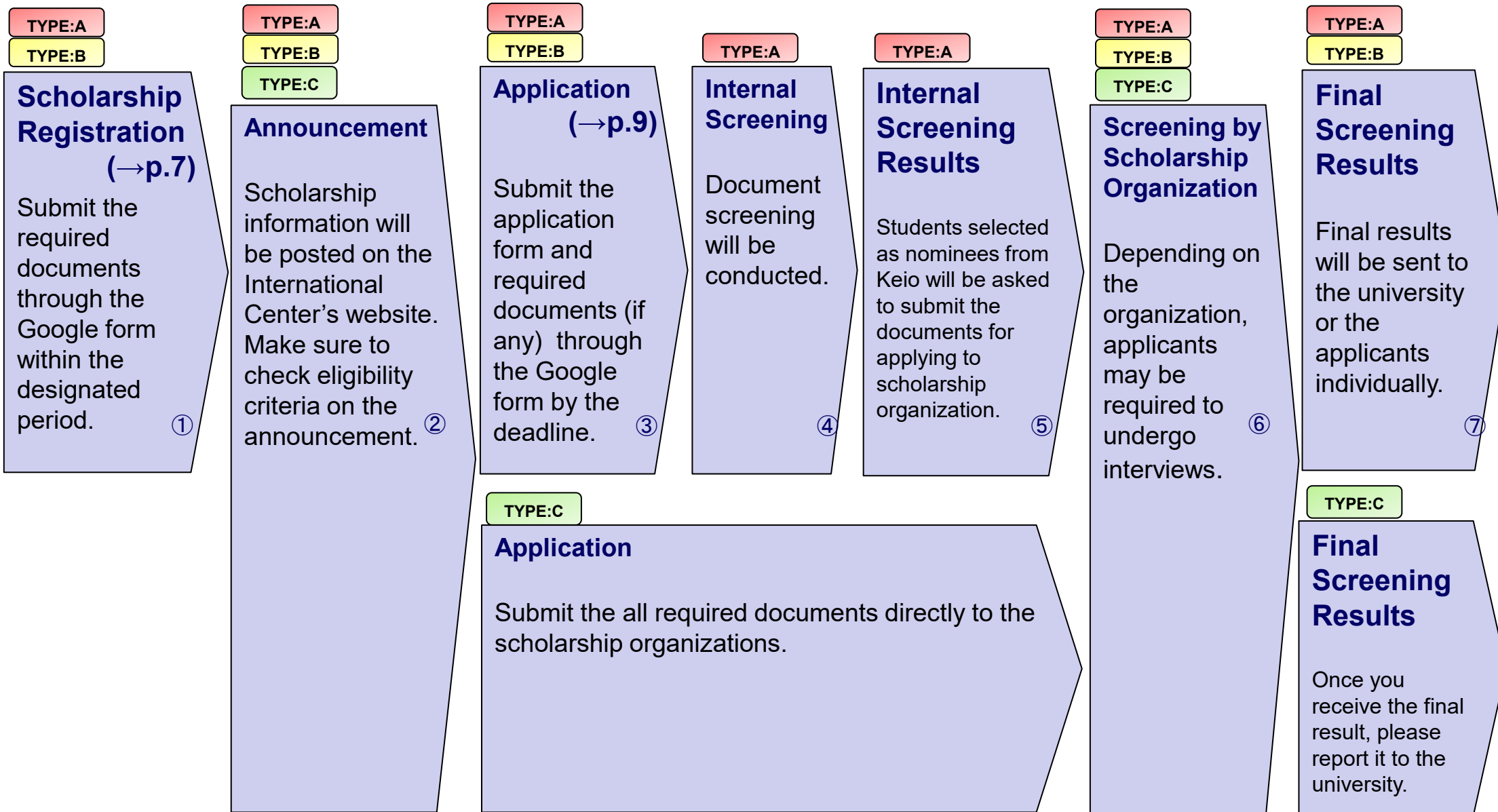

3. Types of application



Applications through the university ※“Scholarship Registration” is necessary	
TYPE:A University Recommendation ※Type ①②③ of p.4	Students apply for the scholarships through Keio University. After internal screening Keio will recommend nominees to each scholarship committee / foundation. Mainly refers to Scholarships provided by Keio University / Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship / JASSO Scholarship / Private Foundation Scholarships. (Detailed application procedures will be explained from the next slide.)
TYPE:B University Application ※Type③	Students gather all required documents themselves and submit them to Keio University. Keio University will send all required documents to the awarding organization. This type of application does not require any internal screening.
Application directly to the awarding organization	
TYPE:C Direct Application ※Type③	Students gather all of the required documents and apply directly to the scholarship organizations themselves. Information about direct application scholarships is posted on the "Scholarships Now Available" page of the International Center website.

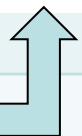


★*There are 2 steps to apply for main scholarships*★

◆Before being able to apply for scholarships...

You have to complete **Scholarship Registration**. It is *an entry (sign up) form* for scholarship selection. Only students who have completed registration are eligible to apply for scholarships through Keio University during the semester until the next scholarship registration period (expected in late-March of the following year). Please confirm the details and the required documents from the following website.

Registration period (Strict Deadline)	<p>◆CURRENT Students: From March 17 (Mon.) - 11:00 AM on March 24 (Mon.), 2025. *It is NOT acceptable for current students to register after March 25.</p> <p>◆NEW Students: From April 1 (Tue.) - 11:00 AM on April 8 (Tue.), 2025 *New students should register after April 1.</p>

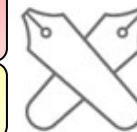

Scholarship Amount	100,000 JPY monthly
Scholarship Duration	One year or less from October 2021 or from April 2022 (It begins in the same semester that you enrolled in Keio University.)
Eligible Applicants (as of October 1 st , 2021)	Master 1 st and 2 nd Doctor 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd Doctor 4 th (for Graduate Schools of Medicine and of Pharmaceutical Sciences.) *For undergraduate students, only GIGA and PEARL students can apply.
Eligibility Criteria	The scholarship is open to students who are enrolled in the Fall Semester, who demonstrate academic excellence with exceptional moral character, and who have been deemed necessary to receive financial support. Applicants must also meet one of the following criteria: ① graduate students who are involved in research that contribute towards international cooperation ② privately financed international students enrolled in degree programs held in English ③ short-term international students (see Application Guideline for definition). Students receiving more than 30,000 yen monthly from another scholarship cannot apply. Students must attend social meetings organized by the foundation and submit monthly designated reports. Students who cannot enter Japan after having enrolled in Keio University and are taking remote classes are NOT eligible. Proficiency in Japanese is not required, but students must submit their application documents with the Japanese translation attached. For undergraduate students, only those enrolled in the GIGA program in Policy Management or Environment and Information Studies and PEARL program in Economics are eligible to apply. *Applicants have to have completed the Scholarship Applicant Registration for the spring semester of 2021 academic year.

5. Important Notes (1)

1. You can simultaneously apply to several university recommendation scholarships.
2. Even after officially selected to receive a Keio University recommendation to the awarding organization, you can still apply to other scholarships which allows other scholarships to be combined if the scholarship organization that you are being recommended allows you simultaneous receipt of other scholarship. However, the scholarship application and receipt status will be taken into account during the internal selection process.
3. International students who are currently receiving scholarships and who are determined to continue to receive scholarships in the following fiscal year cannot apply for scholarships from other organizations that do not allow simultaneous scholarships. Please read the application guidelines carefully.
4. Once officially selected to receive a university recommendation to the awarding organization, you will not be recommended to other scholarships which do not allow to combine with other scholarships.
5. If you are selected to receive both a university recommendation scholarship and a direct application scholarship, yet are not allowed to receive both simultaneously, you must give priority to the university recommendation scholarship. Students must take responsibility and withdraw from the direct application scholarship themselves.
6. Once you have been selected as a scholarship recipient, you cannot withdraw. Please carefully evaluate your financial need when you consider applying for scholarships with smaller award amounts.

5. Important Notes (2)



7. The university will not disclose the progress of the selection process or reasons for selection.
8. If an applicant has provided any false or misleading information, their application will be revoked.
9. If the student is selected but is deemed unsuitable for the scholarship, their scholarship may be revoked. In this case, the recipient must return a portion or the full amount of the scholarship.
10. There are some scholarships for which students with outstanding tuition fees cannot apply to.
11. If you decide to receive a direct application scholarship, please make sure to inform the appropriate office on your campus.
