## Welcome to Keio Co-op

Most cooperative services are available only in Japan. Therefore, please complete the procedure to join the Co-op after arriving in Japan. However, you can still join after enrolling at the university. For more details, refer to the documents provided by the university upon your arrival in Japan.

## What is Keio Co-op?

Keio Co-op is a cooperative organization financed, utilized, and managed by undergraduates, graduate students, administrative staff, and faculty of Keio University. Its purpose is to enhance university life. The Co-op operates cafeterias, school stores, bookstores, and ticket agencies on each campus.

## Why should you become a member of Keio Co-op?

Unlike typical stores, the Co-op is sustained through investments made by diverse members of the Keio community, including students, staff, and faculty. Membership allows anyone on campus to access Co-op services and facilities, making it an essential part of university life.

## How to become a member of Keio Co-op?

To join, students are encouraged to invest a total of 20,000 yen (20 shares of the Co-op). However, the minimum required investment for membership is 1,000 yen (1 share). The full amount of the investment will be refunded upon graduation.

- c) Finally, bring a copy of the deposit slip and your application form to the co-op store or send them by post in a reply envelope. After that, it will be possible to display the member's card on the smartphone within 2 weeks to 1 month.
