10. Qualifications

Applicants are required to:

1. appreciate the educational and research principles of Keio University Shonan Fujisawa Campus (SFC);
2. have a cutting-edge work in practice or outstanding achievements, in the areas of media arts, media design, and media engineering;
3. have a Ph.D. (or the equivalent in educational and research works) in the areas related to media arts, media design, and media engineering; or is expected to acquire one within five years;
4. possess the ability to use English for educational and research purposes;
5. be able to implement collaborative activities, including those outside areas of expertise; and
6. be able to live in Japan and commute to SFC.

11. Application Deadline Monday, March 31, 2014 (Applications must arrive by this date.)

12. Starting Date September 2014 or Academic Year 2015

13. Application Materials (Documents should be A4 size)
1. CV (including full name, date of birth, nationality, contact address, education, employment history, areas of expertise, and recent photo. Signed or sealed.)
 2. List of works (research papers, books, oral presentations, courses taught, portfolio, etc.)
 3. Offprints or copies of three to five representative works. If electronic media are to be used, acceptable media are CD-ROMs and DVD-ROMs. Data should be saved as PDF files (in A4 format).
 4. Essay (approximately 1000 words) describing educational and research achievements, concepts for future educational and research goals, and designs for contributing to SFC
 5. Letters of reference from two separate referees

Submitted materials will not be returned.

14. Selection Process Document Screening; First Interview (you may be asked to present a trial lecture); Second Interview. Details of the process will not be publicly disclosed. Notification of a decision will be sent to each applicant by postal mail.
15. Tenure-track Position If selected for a tenure-track position, the faculty member can apply for tenure in the second and fourth years at SFC. If the decision of the fourth year review is negative, there will be no future opportunities for a tenured position. However, the term of employment can be extended a maximum of one year for a fifth year of employment if both the University and the faculty member come to such an agreement.
