We will be conducting the second-round screening for the Fall AO 2020 as follows.

## Regarding the second-round screening

As described in the Application Guidebook, we will be holding face-to-face interview examinations at Keio University Shonan Fujisawa Campus (SFC).

\*In principle, we will not be conducting remote interviews or taking other special measures for applicants who cannot come to the interview examination.

## Measures to prevent infections when conducting interview examinations

- Your body temperature will be checked when entering the campus. Please make sure to go through the gate where the temperature check is conducted on the day of your interview. Those who have a fever (of 37.5°C or higher) are not allowed to enter the campus, so please refrain from taking the examination if you are exhibiting such symptom.
- Please wear a mask regardless of whether you have any symptoms, to help prevent infections inside the examination venue. In addition, please refrain from having contact or conversation with others to the extent possible.
- Interview rooms and waiting rooms will be ventilated frequently, while alcohol-based hand sanitizer will be available and desks and chairs disinfected in these rooms.
- We kindly ask anyone who is accompanying you on the day of your interview to refrain from taking a bus from Tsujido or Shonandai and from entering the campus grounds. Please ask them to wait for you around the closest train station to the Shonan Fujisawa Campus or other nearby location. We thank you for your cooperation in preventing the spread of infections.
- Please review "Important notes regarding infectious diseases specified in the School Health and Safety Act that prohibit sick students from taking examinations" (partially modified information from that provided on page 35 of the Application Guidebook is reproduced below).

[Important notes regarding infectious diseases specified in the School Health and Safety Act that prohibit sick students from taking examinations]

As of the day of the examination, individuals who have contracted and not yet recovered from an infectious disease that requires them to stay home as detailed in the School Health and Safety Act (including those who have

been designated by the public health center, etc., in the immediate run-up to the examination date as having been in close contact with someone who is infected with COVID-19) must refrain from taking their examinations as there is a risk of infecting others, including applicants and examination proctors. However, this will not apply if either a doctor at the school or other medical institution deems that there is no concern of the medical condition infecting others. Please note that even if you refrain from taking examinations for the above reason, measures such as the provision of makeup examinations or return of application fees will not be taken.

\*The above are the decisions made as of November 4, 2020. If the circumstances surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic worsen in the future and we judge that it will be difficult to conduct interview examinations, we may take appropriate measures, including the cancellation of the second-round screening. Notices will be posted on the university's official website in the case that additional notifications are needed, so please make sure to check the website regularly.
